

## PVA Web site offers access to property data

The McCracken County property valuation administrator's office has a new Web site that provides detailed information about real estate-related issues in McCracken County.

The information includes information about the PVA's office, property tax information, links to important telephone numbers and access to records on each parcel of real estate in the county.

Access to the property tax roll is by subscription only, and the rate is \$100 for 120 hits.

Property Valuation Administrator Nancy Bock said subscribers include banks, attorneys, real estate agents and others who need quick access to detailed property information.

Non-subscribers can get information about their property by contacting the PVA's office.

The new site information includes subdivision maps, information about neighboring properties, listings of recent property sales in the neighborhood, a listing of recent property sales in the county and detailed infor-

mation about each property, including assessment, estimated taxes and information about improvements made to the property.

Bock said a professional design company prepared the site and at least a dozen counties are preparing similar sites.
